



BIZON - ZD - Joint (Clamping) Nails

ZD - Joint (Clamping) nails for angular connection of wooden boards,

most commonly used by coffin producers.















Drawings below depict their use:

- 1) joined boards with a cut for the ZD12 joint nail, made by a 1,6mm thick saw and 10 mm deep in both boards.
- 2) the ZD nail length selection rule.
- 3) the joint cross-section showing the convergent shape of the nail this ensures that the joined boards are pulled tightly together.
- 4) ready connection visible from above.
